Dougie's Disposal - Solid Waste Guidelines provided to Lake Shannon Residents

Dougie's Disposal services started on January 2, 2023 with pickup on Monday's for both trash and weekly recycling.

- Please have your receptacles out by 6:00 AM or the night before. They will **NOT** be able to return to pick up trash or recycling that is not put out in time.
- Please place your trash bin and recycling container on the opposite side of the driveway to avoid confusion and away from obstacles.
- Each household has been provided with one 96 gallon trash bin. Extra trash carts are available at a cost to the homeowner \$72.00 annually. You will be billed directly by Dougies for the extra bin.

• Anything outside your cart **MUST** be called into the office, a week before your pick up day. Extra fees may apply. This includes but is NOT limited to: Extra carts/containers, Extra Bags, Bulk Items, Etc.

• Our contact provides for 4 bulk items allowed per year and **MUST** be scheduled for pickup a week in advance. If you exceed 4, you must call a week in advance and obtain a quote based on weight and size and schedule the pickup. The homeowner will be billed directly by Dougles.

• Cardboard boxes, paper sacks, metal/plastic barrels, or trailers are not approved containers.

• The following items are not accepted: Tires, Shingles, Brick, Concrete, Hazardous Waste Materials. Dried empty latex paint cans are acceptable and can be placed next to your trash bin, with the lid off. Hazardous Waste Materials please refer to the following website: <u>milivcounty.gov</u> or www.<u>lake-shannon.com</u>

Yard Waste

- Yard waste pick up is from April through November with a 10 bag per week maximum. Homeowners will be charged \$1.00 per bag if they exceed the weekly maximum, by Dougie's Disposal.
- Yard waste will only be accepted in brown paper yard waste bags with a weight limit of 50 lbs per bundle.
- Residents should place their yard waste at the curbside next to their cart on their normal collection day by 6am.

Recycling

• Lake Shannon contract provides weekly recycling, please refer to the recycling brochure guidelines.

Please break down cardboard into 3x3 bundles and make sure your recycling is clean.

• Dougie's does NOT provide carts or bins for recycling. You can use any bin up to 96 gallons, identified as recycling. Recycling should be out by 6 AM and in the opposite corner of the trash bin.

Dougie's holidays are New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas. If our trash pickup day falls on or after a holiday, pickup will be delayed one day for that week. Please check the calendar at www.<u>lake-shannon.com</u>
